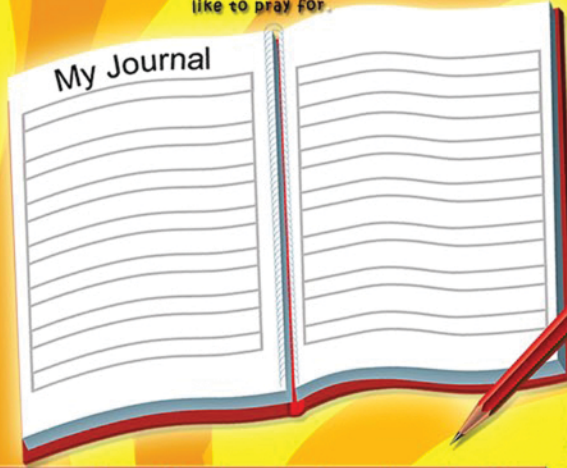

The story of Shadrach, Meshach, and Abednego is a wonderful example of three young boys who bravely stood firmly and confidently on the Word of God above the word of the king. They obeyed the Lord and would not go against God's Word that commands us "You shall not have any other God besides Me" (Exodus 20:3). To remain faithful to God they risked losing their life and facing a fiery furnace. They realized that a life without God was not really living at all. They knew that God could rescue them if He wanted to, but they loved God so much that they were willing to face the fire for Him. God did save them because they obeyed His commands and they trusted Him above all others - even above those who threatened to harm them. In fact, the Lord was even in the fire with them. Be encouraged that no matter what difficulty you are walking through, if you obey God and trust Him, He will walk right beside you and carry you through.
