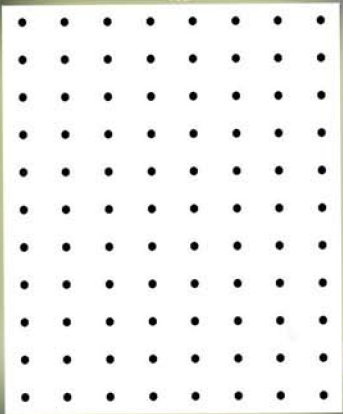

**Rules:**
